DOGMA

Welcome to the 2022 Real Wine Fair!

The Real Wine Fair is an independent festival of natural growers and winemakers, comprising those who work organically and/or biodynamically and with few or zero interventions in the winery. That said, real wine is relative rather than an absolute or precise term and embodies a certain spirit of endeavour in the vineyard and the winery. We understand that each grower has a highly specific approach; we should celebrate those differences.

Real wines tend to be made in small quantities by artisan or independent producers who work without chemicals (which means no artificial fertilisers, pesticides or herbicides) in low-yielding vineyards and then vinify without artificial yeasts or enzymes, or recourse to acidification or other adjustments. Many are made with only tiny amounts of added sulphur and some with none at all. 'Nowt taken out and nowt put in', as the saying goes. The motivation is to rediscover the true flavour of wine by capturing the sense of place (terroir) and the very nature of the vintage.

These wines are individual, hand-crafted, thrilling and unpredictable. They remind us that wine can be a living thing rather than a denatured product and that less intervention means more real flavour.

This booklet contains details of hundreds of wines from many countries around the world presented by growers and winemakers who have stories to tell.

We hope you enjoy these wines as much as we do. And if you want to buy a bottle or several, or order something you have tasted at the fair there is a pop-up shop by the entrance of the main hall!

And wine is only part of the Fair. Check out the artisan food tables and grab a bite from one of the stalls or attend one of the fascinating Real Wine seminars and masterclasses.

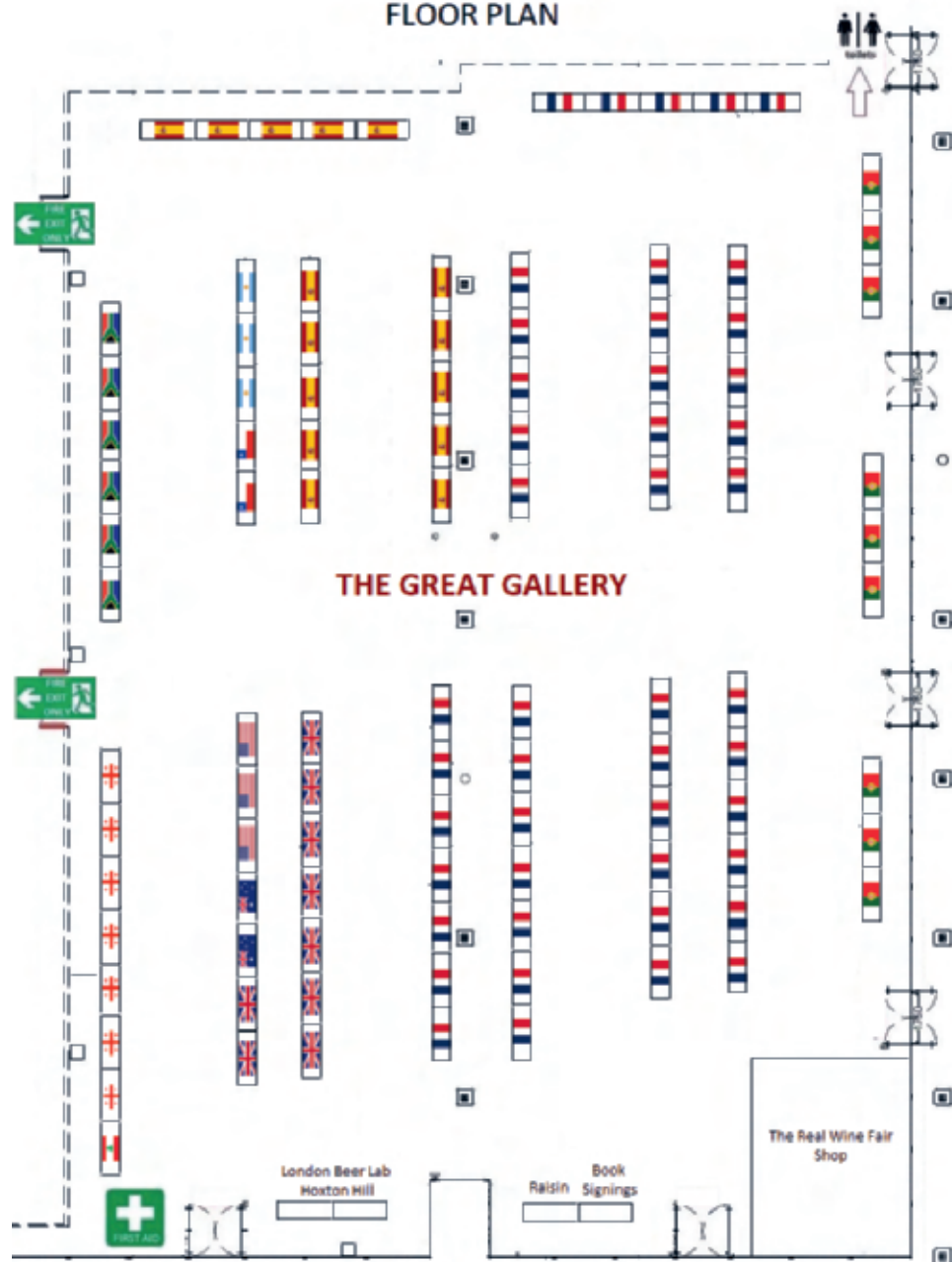

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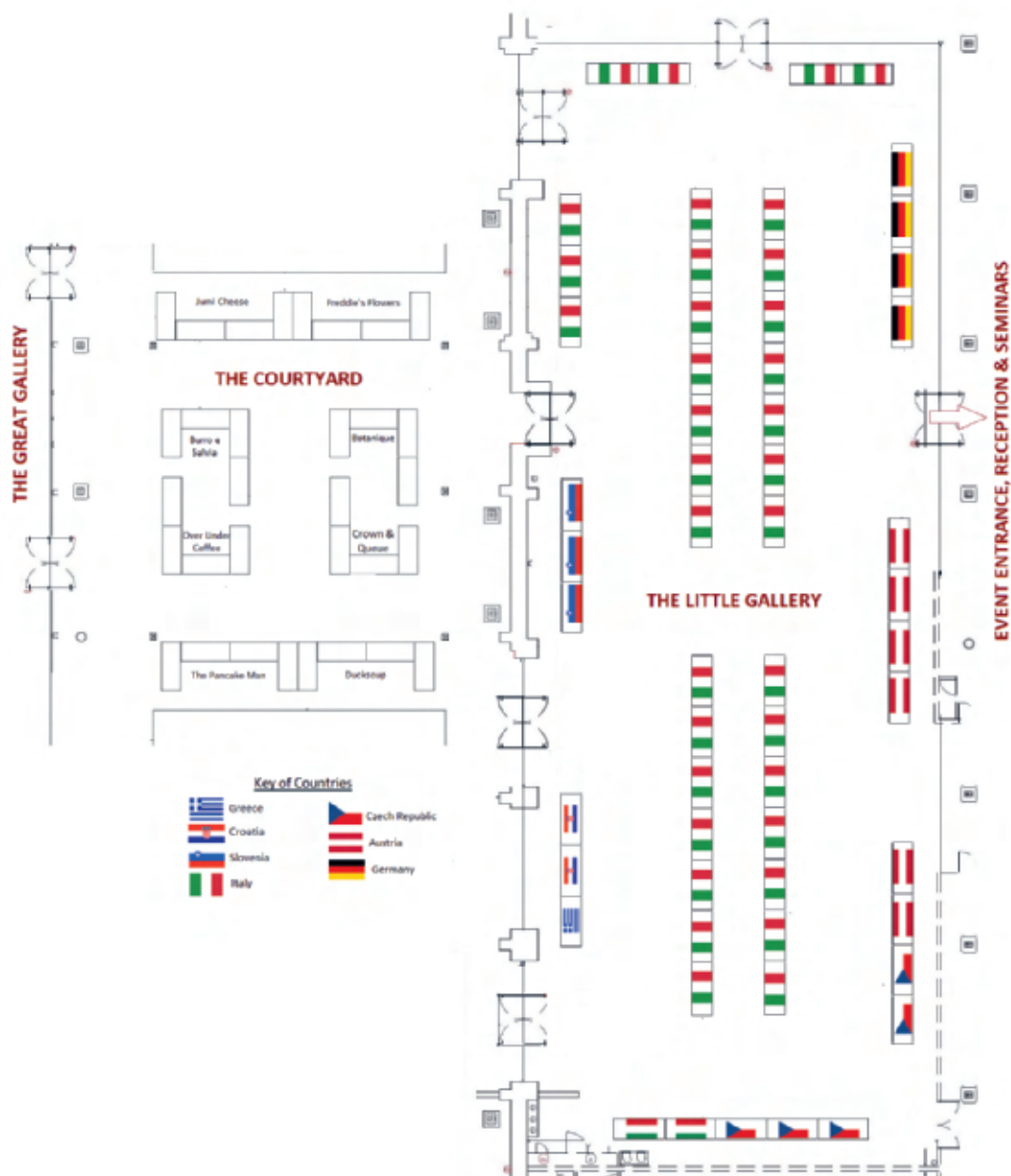
THE GREAT GALLERY FLOOR PLAN

The Real Wine Fair – The Partners

These are the people who, along with the winemakers, have helped make the fair happen. If you fancy finding out more about what they do, check out their websites.

Les Caves de Pyrène - www.lescaves.co.uk - Les Caves de Pyrène, a wine importer, distributor and agent, was founded in 1988. Initially it was four people, a battered van and a small handful of wines from South West France. Despite our subsequent growth, our philosophy remains the same as it did from the beginning: to source the best quality wines directly from the grower and the vineyard; that these wines should reflect where they come from (the expression of “terroir”); that these wines should be sustainable, with low intervention and preferably organic or biodynamic; that we not only sell these wines with energy and passion but provide the service that helps our customers to connect more effectively with their customers.

Modal Wines - www.modalwines.com - is an importer of small-batch, distinctive wines, grown and produced with love and respect, regardless of location. Modal scales in music sit outside the more common and ordinary major and minor scales – out of the many parallels between music and wine, this particular concept beautifully illustrates the aim at Modal Wines: to source unique wines with the right mix of edge, character, balance, and drinkability – at times surprising, but always thoroughly enjoyable. A deep-rooted respect for nature unites all the producers in their portfolio, the onus being on wines made with as little interference in the vineyards and cellar as possible.

Portuguese Story - www.portuguesestory.com - We are traders and story tellers who want to give a Portuguese narrative to the world, to change people's perceptions and to bring the diversity and uniqueness of Portugal out. One of the ways we want people to engage is through the local and unique and characteristic quality products. Wine can be a strong ambassador of native character and for Portugal this could not be truer. Our vision is that by bringing wine to other markets we will help and encourage people to discover and value Portugal, and help Portugal find its true respected place in the modern world.

Roland Wines - www.rolandwines.co.uk - is an importer sourcing wine from a niche market with a clear mission. Find the heroes of Central and Eastern Europe - those producers - who are willing to conquer their land by growing grapes in a sustainable manner, respecting nature. Our vintners produce their own wines with the least intervention possible to make it a true reflection of their origin. We are proud to present what we believe Hungary, Slovakia, Slovenia and Croatia have to offer.

Provisions - www.provisionslondon.co.uk - Provisions is a wine and cheese importer with shops in Holloway Road and Hackney Road, the former opening in 2015 and the latter in April 2022. They import and wholesale carefully selected, artisan products from small, natural and organic producers, mainly in France and Italy, but also across Europe. They work with organic/biodynamic natural wine makers with the aim of making wine and artisan food affordable and accessible.

Under the Bonnet - www.winesutb.com - was set up in January 2015 by two friends and fellow restaurateurs (Basile & Alex), to buy the kind of natural wines that they themselves like to drink in their favourite bars, restaurants and at home. These are wines from places close to their hearts; around Nantes, Angers and Saumur in the west of the Loire valley. The growers they work with operate simply, respecting their natural environment. To Basile and Alex, the people behind these bottles are just as important as the grapes themselves.

Indigo Wine - www.indigowine.com - is an importer and agent of unique and artisanal wines from around the world. They are proud to distribute these wines to the UK's best restaurants and independent retailers. They are best known for sourcing fresh and balanced wines from Spain, most notably from producers in lesser-known regions, who work with indigenous varieties. Over the years their portfolio has extended to include some real gems from Portugal, Austria, Italy, Australia, South Africa, Chile and beyond. They work hard to find talented growers who are committed to making real, honest and above all delicious wines.

Basket Press Wines – www.basketpresswines.com – is a London-based wine import and distribution company. Their focus is sourcing real, living wines from Central & Eastern Europe and they aim to work with and support smaller, unsung growers. This group of winemakers have dared to go back to traditional winemaking methods, that is to farm organically and allow the wines to follow their natural evolution in the cellar. Amongst them are the true pioneers, those who have paved the way for younger growers in their region to believe in themselves and go beyond the dogmatic approaches.

Otros Vinos – www.otrosvinos.co.uk – Otros Vinos represent a handful of winemakers from Spain and the south of France. All these producers work small vineyards, farm organically or biodynamically and practise as little intervention in the cellar as possible. They produce wines that absolutely shimmer with terroir and reflect the wonderful people that produce them.

Dogma – www.dogma.wine – Dogma was born in the basement of Black's Club in Soho in 2016, as a result of a conversation between Giueseppe Mascoli and Francesco Cali about indigenous yeasts. Seven years on the founders are still focussed on sourcing and importing purely artisanal wines, (for now only from Italy), which must be naturally fermented. This is their one and only “dogma”. Some growers are biodynamic, others working organically and sustainably – and all relatively small operations with productions varying from 3,000 – 40,000 bottles per year.

The Real Wine Shop

The Real Wine Shop is located by the entrance of the Great Gallery. It will be selling a selection of wines to take away by the bottle during fair days and will be able to process larger orders for later delivery.

EVENTS & SEMINARS

There will be a series of talks given by wine growers during the two days of the fair, details of which are given below.

Sunday 22nd May

12.00 – 12.45 pm – *“Pair Food & Wine Like a Pro”* with **Sam Povey** of **Provisions Wine School** (provisionswineschool.co.uk), a London-based wine school with a focus on organic, biodynamic and natural wine. You will have the opportunity to sample a range of snacks and wine and try your hand at finding the best pairings!

1.30 – 2.15 pm – *“Georgian Artisan Wine – 10 Years On”*. **John Wurdeman**, from Pheasant’s Tears Winery in Kakheti, describes the massive changes in the Georgian natural wine scene over the past decade alone, not only the progress at home, but also the perception of (and admiration for) Georgian wines in wine-loving countries around the world.

3.00 – 3.45pm – *“Perceptions Of Natural Wine In The Trade in 2022”*. It has been nearly fifteen years since natural wine burst onto the scene in the UK and ten years since the first Real Wine Fair. Bianka and Daniel's winery has been in the family for over 200 years. They work their 16 parcels in the Rheinhessen biodynamically, making wines that are pure and fresh, "just from grapes". Rheinhessen is the largest wine growing region in Germany, and has been largely associated with bulk wine production. However, in recent years, the perception of the region has begun to shift as a younger generation of innovative growers are working to reduce yields and focus on the largely undervalued terroir of this region. Weingut Schmitt has been working biodynamically for over a decade and they are one of only 80 wineries in Germany to be Demeter certified.

Bergkloster, Jason Groebe

Region: Rheinhessen, Germany

Young, passionate, with a big heart and a bit of swagger, Jason is part of a group of young winemakers rocketing the wine region of Rheinhessen. It is one of the most beautiful parts of Germany, as they also call it “the land of thousand hills”. Wine has been produced for a long time here, supposedly brought in by the Romans. vJason marks the 5th generation of winemakers at Bergkloster, “abbey on the hill” in German, which has been in their family for over 120 years. The winery has been working organically since 2006, on 7.7ha. After many trials Jason started to take over the estate bit by bit in 2018, he makes wines with minimal intervention.

After studying in Geisenheim, Martin gained experience with Matassa and Gut Oggau. He now manages 3 hectares in Flonheim. Weiss comes from a co-planted organically farmed cover cropped vineyard, vines up to 60 years old. Soil is sandstone, yields are low. The Weiss blend is 20% Mueller Thurgau, 20% Faberrebe, 20% Bacchus, 15% Wuerzer 15% Riesling 15% Silvaner and 10% Scheurebe. All grapes are harvested together and co-fermented, whole bunch with two weeks of skin contact in stainless vat with indigenous yeast and then transferred to be aged in old foudre barrels of between 1250l - 2500l. There it undergoes a full malolactic before being bottled without fining, filtering or any sulphur. The Riesling is naturally fermented in large barrels and bottled without sulphur or filtration. Crazy Crazy is a col fondo style of Weiss (think natural German Prosecco), the reds are light and crunchy.

Max Dexheimer

Region: Rheinhessen, Germany

The Max Dexheimer winery is located in Saulheim, in the center of Rheinhessen. The Walldorf brothers founded the winery in 1896. Max is the 5th generation of winemakers in his family, and he continues his family's winemaking history by also adding the perspective that winemaking is a balance of nature and workmanship. According to his values vineyards are worked by hand, it goes without saying that the grapes are also harvested only and strictly by hand. The limestone soil in his vines is the key factor, which is reflected in the wines, which add to the wines a flinty minerality and a lot of beautiful tension. In order to produce unique, characterful, and expressive wines, grapes are cultivated and cared for according to basic biodynamic principles. In the cellars, wines are all spontaneously fermented with their own yeast and aged in old large traditional German Stuckfass or high-quality burgundy oak barrels.

Starting out bottling in 2012, they experimented for some years before releasing their first vintage in 2015 under the label Weingut Fuchs und Hase. All grapes are grown in Kamptal using organic processes and they add no sugar, yeast or sulphur.

Born into a winemaking family in eastern Kamptal, Austria, and with extensive winery experience in New Zealand, Germany and South Africa, the young Christoph Heiss divides his time between carrying on the family winery – Weingut Heiss – and a growing focus on his own wines under the Malinga label. Using carefully chosen parcels of Weingut Heiss' 12 hectares of vines, Christoph has developed a very small production of stunning natural wines, which brim with energy and personality. Organically farmed grapes are hand-harvested, spontaneously fermented and gently aged in the family's underground cellar, before being bottled unfinned and unfiltered with low sulphite additions.

The Andert-Wein estate covers 4.5ha in the south of the Seewinkel, Burgenland in Austria. A family business, run by the Andert brothers; Erich and Michael, the estate has been certified biodynamic since 2003. The brothers love good wine and food and so throughout the vineyards herbs and vegetables grow bountifully alongside a variety of animals. The most important thing for them is that the natural wine processes are not disturbed in the cellar; fermentation is spontaneous and there is no temperature control, wines are left to develop naturally, gaining individuality and character.

Judith Beck's wines are in the best sense natural, genuine and above all authentic. Since 1976 the area under vine has increased from 5 to 15 ha and from 2007 the wines have been produced in accordance with biodynamic principles. The aim is to produce authentic wines with an individual aroma profile whilst at the same time maintaining healthy soils and vines. Always more discreet than loud, the wines are always worth a second look. In Judith Beck's own words: "International style can be produced by everyone, everywhere. My wines are my own, they are here and now and that is, for me, the most beautiful thing."

Jaroslav Osicka is a small family-run winery located in Velké Bílovice, where they manage 3.5 hectares of vines. The winery is growing and producing wines in a harmony with nature. Characteristic traits of the winery: environmentally friendly production, the vineyards and grapes are treated in the organic regime for the last 20 years, spontaneously fermented wine, long period ageing in oak and acacia barrels. The wines are not filtered and sulphites are added in small amount right before bottling.

The creation of the Royal Imperial Estate of Tokaj-Hétszőlő estate owes nothing to chance: in 1502 the Garai family simply selected the best 7 parcels of the land in the region, hence the name – Hét Szolo which means “7 parcels of vineyard” in Hungarian, it has been under vine ever since. The site certainly has an illustrious history having been owned by the Habsburg royal family for two centuries. Now the vineyard is tended in line with environmental principles and the estate is cultivated organically. Ecological islands have been established next to vine parcels to increase biodiversity. Allied to these changes is a move towards more natural winemaking, using indigenous yeasts and spontaneous fermentation.

Kristinus is located on the southwestern shore of Central Europe's largest natural lake, Balaton. The farm is home to animals, pastures, orchards, woodland and vines and began biodynamic conversion in 2018. Kristinus are passionate about promoting soil health and biodiversity in their environment. The application of ecology-islands, insect hotels and indigenous cover crops all contribute to the harvest of high-quality, healthy grapes. By fermenting a high percentage of their wines on the skin in clay vessels, the natural characteristics of the grape obtain full exposure. Autochthonous varieties Kékfrankos, Furmint and Welschriesling are the key plantings of this winery.

Almost all of her vines are Montepulciano, but she also has a couple of rows of Trebbiano. These vines, on average, are 40-years-old, and are 450 metres above sea level. Soils are calcareous clay mixed with alluvial sediment and fossil remains. The vines are trained in the traditional tendone-style pergola, and all the work is done by hand. She intentionally keeps her yields low. She prefers, as do we, her wines to have acidity and freshness rather than power and extraction.
